

To Qualify the Promotion

Promotion Policy is based on 3 Phases of Progressive Evaluation during the Term period (including grade wise assessments)

Phase I: First Term Examination

Phase II: Second Term Examination (mid of academic year)

Phase III: Third Term Examination (end of academic year)



Aggregate Result Compilation:

Phase I: First Term Examination 10%

Phase II: Second Term Examination (mid of academic year) 30%

Phase III: Third Term Examination (end of academic year) 60%

Final Examination: *Aggregate System 100%



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Promotion Committee

The Promotion Committee comprises the following:

- > Principal
- > Head Mistress
- **➢** Wing/Section Head
- **▶** Head of Department (HOD of relevant subject)
- Subject Teacher (if required)

All promotions to be decided by the Promotion Committee.

Action Plan

- Wing/Section Head to generate the list of detainees with the reason for detention **before** the declaration of results. Review Committee appointed by the Principal reviews the cases of the detainees and gets their papers rechecked.
- Headmistress will forward the final names of detainees with a reason of their detention to the Principal. Cases to be discussed in the Review session conducted by Academic Branch. The decision of the Promotion Committee will be considered final.
- Exam Branch falling under the Academic Branch will put up the result of the Detainees to the Promotion Committee. The decision will be finalized in the meeting.
- Grace marks up to 3 on the overall result may be granted by the Principal only.
- All the students registered with FBISE at SSC & HSSC level must appear for FBISE Annual Examination.
- Remedial and Re-Test (SSC & HSSC) to be held for only those students who could not appear perform well in the First Term Examination due to a genuine reason.(cases to be discussed).
- In the First Term Examination Class IX-XII students must qualify 45% marks in All the Subjects.
- There will be <u>NO</u> Re-Exam (Class I-VIII) .Those students who could not appear in First Term Examination due to a genuine reason, First Term Weightage (10%) will be evaluated on the basis of Monthly Tests of 2nd & 3rd Term.

• Classes I-V

Students must secure 40% marks in individual Subjects and 45% marks in the overall aggregate to be eligible for promotion.

• Classes VI-VII

Students must secure 50% marks in individual Subjects and 50% marks in the overall aggregate to be eligible for promotion.

• Class VIII

Students must secure 50% marks in individual Subjects and 50% marks in the overall aggregate to be eligible for promotion.

*Required Criteria for Class IX (New) *Biology 70% marks *Computer Science 60% marks

• Class IX-XII

Students of SSC and HSSC must fulfill the basic criteria set by the FBISE in order to be eligible for FBISE registration/admission.

DETENTION RULES

Preschool: No detentions are allowed Preschool.

Classes' I-VIII:

Any student who is unable to meet the promotion criteria will be detained.

Following will **not** be promoted.

- *Any student who **fails** in **two core subjects**.
- *Any student who **fails** in **one core subject and two non-core subjects**.
- *Any student whose overall result in total (Final Aggregate) is less than:

45% for Classes' I-V

50% for Classes' VI-VIII

Conditional Promotion:

There will be **No** conditional / double promotions.

<u>Double Failure:</u> If a student fails to qualify for promotion in <u>two consecutive academic years</u>, Parents will be asked to withdraw him / her from school by applying SLC.
